Hanging Gladiolus Growers Guide Holder  
Assembly Directions

Use 8-1/2" x 11" 110 lb. card stock for best results.

A laser printer using the manual feed tray is recommended.

Front and back alignment is critical.

Use of duplex mode will not align quite as well.

Print page one, then refeed and print page two on the back.

Scoring with a rotary cutter or very light use of a perforation  
cutter will make folding assembly easier.

Follow steps 1 thru 10 in order

the back, you must create the text as a picture file (\*.jpg), invert
