RAY DITTUS AWARD WINNERS

RULE 1: Only cultivars introduced in the five previous years (2007-2011) are eligible.

RULE 2: Each NAGC sanctioned show will pick a first, second and third place Recent Introduction cultivar in the show. Winners can be selected from the Recent Introduction, Open or Decorative classes or from a culmination of awards won in the entire show. The Recent Introduction champ is usually the first selection unless not eligible or worthy.

RULE 3: Entries for this award should be judged by two accredited NAGC judges. **NAGC shows where this is not possible, the head judge or show chairman may make this selection.**

RULE 4: Points will be awarded: 5 for first, 3 for second and 1 for third. Cultivars receiving most points will be declared the winner.

RULE 5: The award will be made to the hybridizer of the selected cultivar at the following NAGC convention.

RULE 6: Once a cultivar wins the Ray Dittus award, it is ineligible to win a second time. The past prize winning cultivars are not eligible for 2011: **SHOWMAN'S DELIGHT, SUPERIOR CHAMP, STAR PERFORMER, and SHOWBOUND.**

RULE 7: Any glad winning the Ray Dittus award will carry the honored label, Ray Dittus Winner and may be advertised as such.
